



Poster Presentation Guidelines for ISDC 2022

Each team (or individual) attending the International Space Development Conference is expected to present a formal poster at the ISDC Space Settlement Student Design Contest Poster Session. In order to present a poster you and/or your team must register for a slot, as spaces are limited upon registration. Due: May 1, 2022.

This poster session will be divided into sessions. Your team/individual will be assigned a presentation group, day and location. The information for the group, day, time and location for the Poster Presentation will be given at the Registration Desk.

Poster Requirements

- The Poster Presentation should highlight each team's project as submitted to the NSS Annual Space Settlement Contest, and it will need to be in a "poster-style" display format.
- The dimensions of the poster presentation should not exceed 1.0 meter (high) by 1.5 meters (wide) [59"x 39"].
- It is acceptable to have posters smaller than this size or to mosaic smaller parts into a larger sized poster.
- Models, flyers, or handouts are also allowed and may be displayed. The National Space Society is not responsible for lost or stolen models.
- No computers or electrical displays are allowed. This is a security issue. The National Space Society is not responsible for lost or stolen computers.
- Access to electrical power to operate computers is severely limited and generally not available.

Students will be asked to two (2) hours at their poster to present details of their project to attendees; this is in addition to the planned 2-hour poster session.

Please have the poster file be in PDF, JPEG or PNG format.

NOTES:

Printing of poster is on your responsibility and should be printed prior to arriving in Arlington.

Posters must have their title and email contact also labelled on the back of the poster and it must be visible when rolled-up (e.g. by sticker, marker or printed).

Entry form must be completed and sent by May 1, 2022 to be considered for a slot. A limited number of space settlement student teams will be assigned a poster session day and time during the conference. Confirmed teams are expected to stand beside their posters and communicate with conference attendees.
